Electronic Catalogue

An integrated search gives information about availability and location of the material at the University of Crete Library in **Heraklion** and **Rethymnon**. Holdings of the **FORTH** Library and the **Natural History Museum of Crete** are also displayed.

Course Reserves

A Library maintained database that provides regularly updated information on the **material related to the taught courses.** It is connected to the Catalogue.

Electronic Journals & Books

A variety of electronic journals and books **for all disciplines** are traced through **integrated title lists** and also through Livesearch.

E - locus: Institutional Repository

Library's electronic collection with **graduate**, **master's theses and doctoral dissertations** as well as other material created by the members of the University of Crete.

Anemi Digital Library A Library maintained rich collection of digitized material related to Modern Greek Studies.

Databases

Scientific databases for all disciplines offer access to abstracts and / or full text of articles.

Livesearch

Federated simultaneous search in most of the Library collections and many other scientific resources all over the word. Results include detailed description and links to the original resource. Access to the resources under subscription is controlled and available only through the University of Crete network.

University of Crete members may access the resources remotely through the **Virtual Private Network** (VPN).

Books

The books are **shelved by subject** and subject categories are described with latin letters. E.g. Q= Science QA= Mathematics QC=Physics QD=Chemistry QH= Biology W=Medicine T= Technology

Main Collection

Books for all disciplines, of Greek and non- Greek language, are available in the main Library area and may be borrowed for **20 days**.

1st floor: books with **Q** and **W** classification Ground floor: books with classification A-P, $\mathbf{R} - \mathbf{V}, \mathbf{X} - \mathbf{Z}$

Short Loan Collection

Copies of books related to the course bibliography are shelved at the Short Loan Collection, which is located behind the Library reception.

Access is restricted and these books may be borrowed for **3** days.

All computers in the Library Computer Room are connected to two **black and white printers and one colour printer**, while at the ground floor area the Computer Corner is equipped with one black and white printer.

There are 3 **black and white** photocopying machines near the Library Reception and 1 in the Journals Room at the ground floor.

Older journal issues are located at the moving shelves room of the ground floor.

Reference collection is located near the Library reception and the material may be used within the Library.

Library staff, specialized on information retrieval and resources, provides every day user support and anyone may ask for help in person, by e-mail or telephone communication.

At the same time, the Library organizes seminars by discipline and study levels, on the use of the Library and the electronic resources throughout the academic year.
